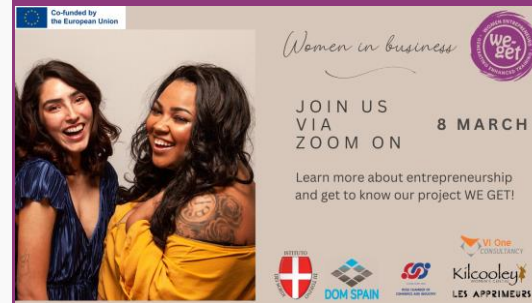
Zoom to Northern Ireland

Our last meeting very aptly fell on International Women's day.

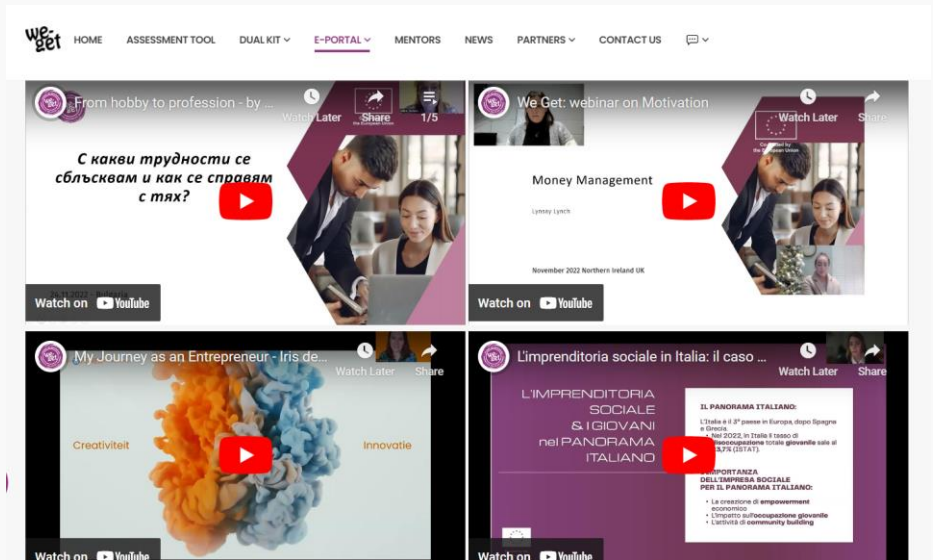
The theme focused on empowerment and equality.
