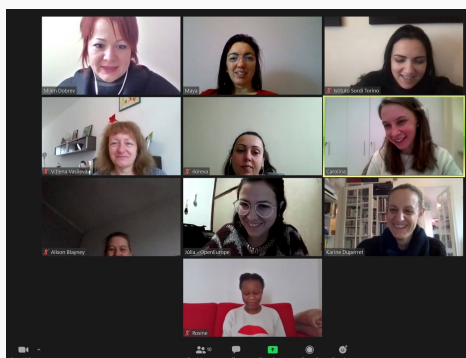

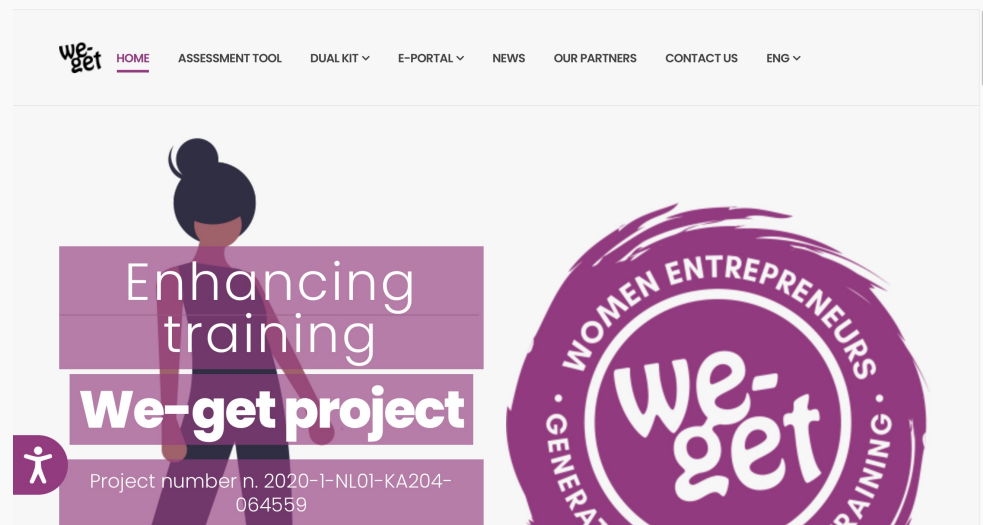

The Toolkit will be developed following consultation with women in business across the European Union to identify the key skills needed, and will provide solutions to the training requirements identified by the partner research.

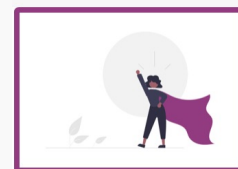

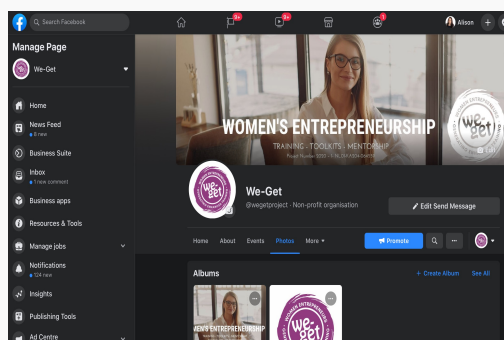

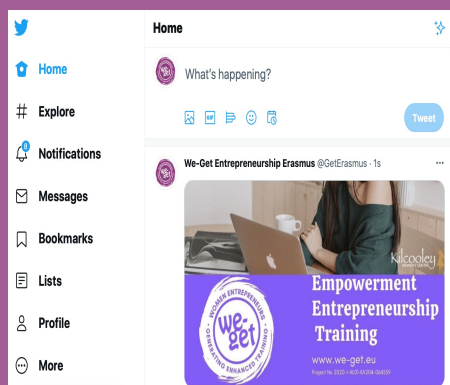
Social media is an important method of engaging participants and disseminating results of the project.
