



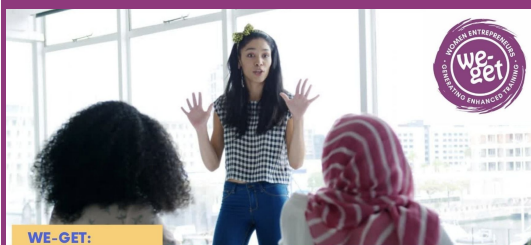

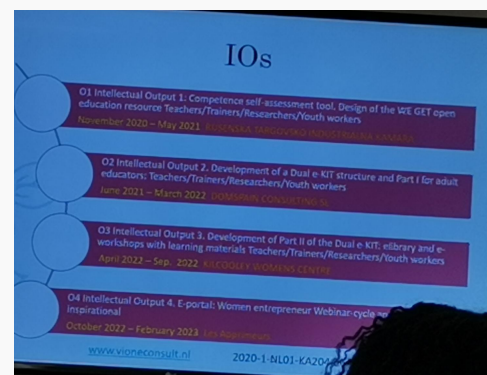
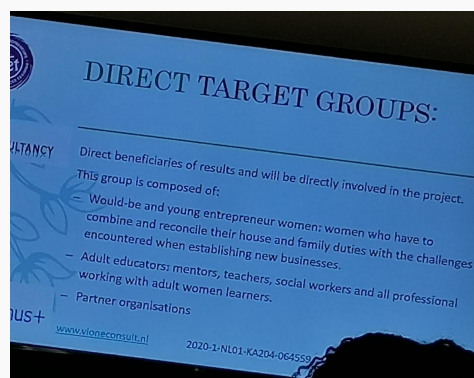


- Mapping Training Needs for Female Entrepreneurs

The next meeting was agreed to be held in Bangor Northern Ireland in Spring.

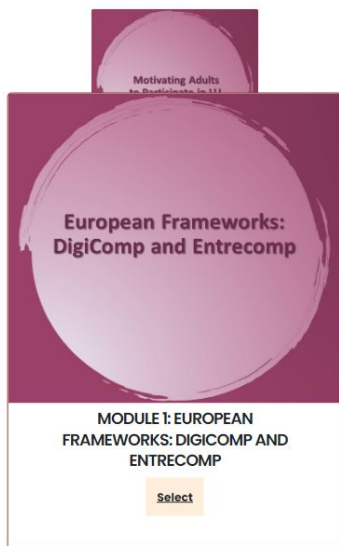

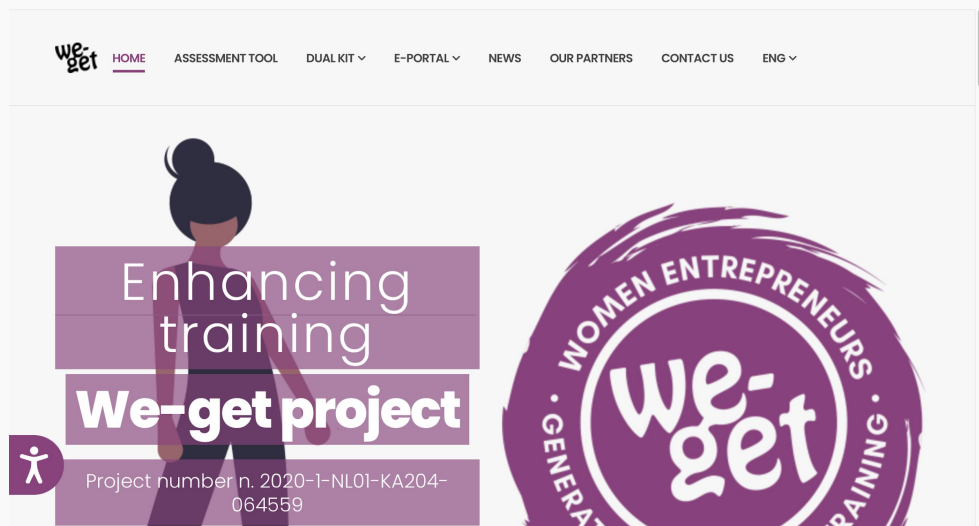

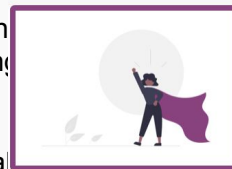

Bangor saw all partners meet face to face again to discuss progress.

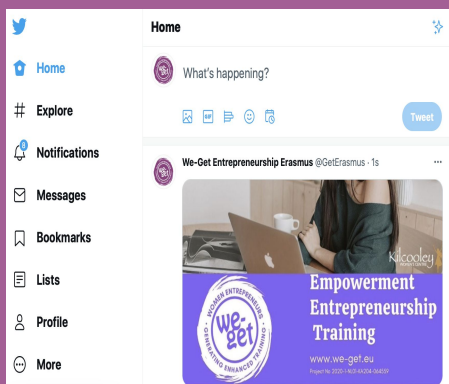
IO3 will have partners once again developing modules, but this time for the entrepreneurs themselves, this enables these women autonomy over their self development.

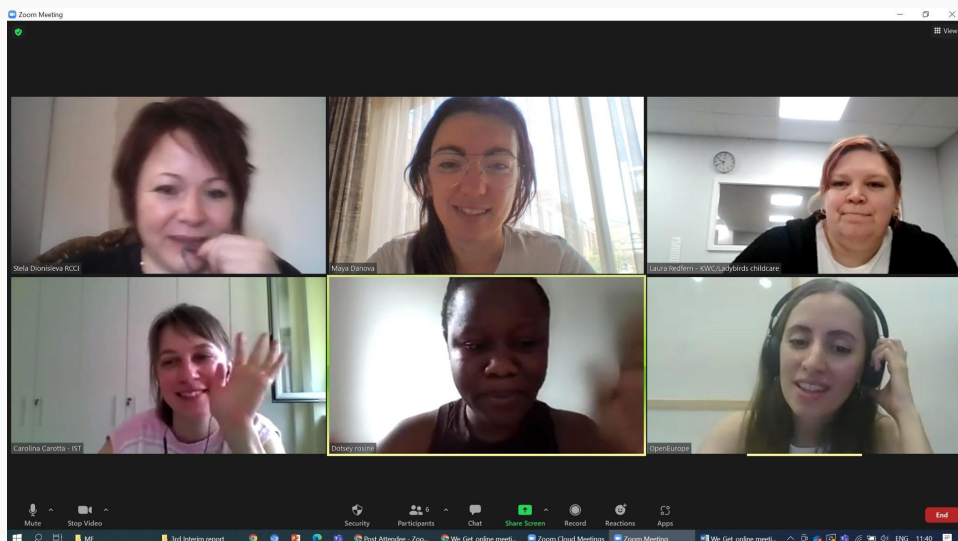
